**Comprehensive Plan, Chapter 7 Transportation and Street Standards**

Community Development Director Pilcher reported the Planning Commission has reviewed the Transportation element of the Comprehensive Plan. Mr. Pilcher also mentioned that due to Council's request to change the LOS standard from D to C the consultant has updated the document and road information to reflect this change. Also updated were time frames.

Public Works Director Boettcher discussed with Council changes to the new street network map versus the old map.

Following discussion Council asked staff to clarify with the consultant which transportation data was used, 2006 or 2007. Council also directed staff to add a policy statement that the City supports Diesel Motorized Units.

In addition, Mr. Pilcher discussed with Council private road pros and cons and the need for different street standards to address older communities within the city.
