**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON
AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE ROBERTS DRIVE
PEDESTRIAN LIGHTING PROJECT BY
TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS INC.**

WHEREAS, Transportation Systems, Inc. has completed the Roberts Drive Pedestrian Lights Project according to the contract and Council authorization; and

WHEREAS, RCW 60.28.011(2) allows a period of forty-five days to file any liens or claims with the City; and

WHEREAS, RCW 39.08.030 requires acceptance of a Public Works project as complete as a formal, public action in order to begin the forty-five day period; and

WHEREAS, 5% retainage funds in the amount of \$1,571.95 will be retained during this 45 day period;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City hereby accepts the Roberts Drive Pedestrian Light Project as complete and as set forth in that contract with Transportation Systems, Inc.
