Roberts Drive Traffic Impacts and Construction Update for the week of 3/13/17 to 3/17/17

The road will remain officially closed to trucks and (2) Police officers will be staged as they have been, (SR 169 & Roberts Drive Intersection and Lake Sawyer Road & Roberts Drive.) The waterline construction has reached a point that we will have (3) different crews working along Roberts Drive in (3) separate locations. The road closure and one lane traffic hours will be in place from 7am to 5pm. Each location will be shut down to one lane and will be controlled by flaggers. See below for effected areas of work and what to expect.

The first operation will be directional drilling near the Diamond Villages area on Monday which will continue throughout the week. The east bound lane of Roberts Drive will be closed and flaggers will control the traffic between 7am and 5pm. During non-working hours there is a traffic revision in that area that is pushing traffic over , both east bound and west bound, to the shoulder for a roughly 100 yards. Children trying to get on and off the bus at the Diamond Villages bus stop, will be assisted and guided with one of our workers for their safety along with a sign telling them where to stand temporarily during construction.

The second operation will be a crew installing a water main on the north shoulder of Roberts Drive. The west bound Lane will be closed and flaggers will control the one lane traffic. Expect long delays as trucks and heavy equipment will be entering in and out of that area constantly throughout the day.

The third operation will be starting at the Rock Creek bridge and heading west towards the Villages project site. The west bound lane will be closed to traffic between 7am-5pm. Beginning Monday an asphalt grinder will begin grinding the asphalt of the west bound lane and a pipe crew will begin working right behind the asphalt grinder installing (2) 12" water mains. This will go from Monday-Thursday next week. Friday of next week we will spend the day paving back the area that has been disturbed.

Please expect long delays all week and use alternative routes to avoid any un-usual traffic delays.
