ORDINANCE NUMBER 05- 789

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING  
COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING A TRAFFIC  
SAFETY SCHOOL FUND

WHEREAS, the City authorized a Traffic Safety School which is administered by the Black Diamond Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Black Diamond Police Department charges a fee to all Traffic School participants in this program and said monies are to bused solely for costs associated with the administration of the Traffic Safety School;

WHEREAS, the fund needs to be separate and apart from the General Fund of the City; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** There is created a fund to be known as the Traffic Safety School Fund in the accounts of the City.

**Section 2.** All fees paid by Traffic Safety School participants shall be deposited into this fund. Said fund is authorized to be a standard savings account.

**Section 3.** The moneys in the Traffic Safety School Fund shall be used solely for costs associated with the administration of the Traffic Safety School.


**Section 4.** Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in force and effect.

**Section 5.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage, approval, posting and publication as provided by law. A summary of this ordinance may be published in lieu of publishing the Ordinance in its entirety.


