COUNTY, WASHINGTON, REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY
ORDINANCE NO. 05-789 REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT
OF A TRAFFIC SAFETY SCHOOL FUND**

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2005 the City passed Ordinance No. 05-782 establishing a Traffic Safety School which is administered by the Black Diamond Police Department;

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2005 the City passed Ordinance No. 05-789 establishing a Traffic Safety School Fund;


WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety School Fund is not necessary and would be burdensome to the City, as the funds are able to be paid into the General Fund and appropriately accounted for; now, therefore

WASHINGTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 1. Ordinance No. 05-789 is hereby repealed in its entirety.


