

RESOLUTION NO. 05 - 373

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL TO PURCHASE A THERMAL IMAGING CAMERA

WHEREAS, the Fire Department currently does not own or have access to a Thermal Imaging Camera,

WHEREAS, the Thermal Imaging Camera is very useful in locating victims in a burning building and,

WHEREAS, the Thermal Imaging Camera is also useful in locating the source of a fire even when obscured by a wall and,

WHEREAS, the Thermal Imaging Camera has also proven useful in locating persons that are lost or have been ejected from a vehicle involved in an accident and,

WHEREAS, we have received a grant from FEMA that funds 90% of the cost of the purchase of a Thermal Imaging Camera and,

WHEREAS, the fire department has solicited bids and reviewed 5 different cameras and received an acceptable bid proposal from the vendor,


