A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH JASON PAULSEN

WHEREAS, Jason Paulsen has been a City employee for over a decade; and

WHEREAS, in his capacity as a City employee Mr. Paulsen has gained a wealth of information regarding pending City projects; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Paulsen will be leaving the City's employ for other employment, effective in September, 2006; and

WHEREAS, in order to assure continuity in project management, the City finds that it is in its best interests to have access to Mr. Paulsen at least through December 31, 2006, now, therefore



**AGREEMENT BETWEEN
CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND AND JASON PAULSEN**

1. Date and Parties.

This agreement, for reference purposes only, is dated the 7th day of September, 2006, and is entered into between the City of Black Diamond, a Washington municipal corporation ("City") and Jason Paulsen ("Jason").

2. Recitals.

a. Jason has been a City employee for over a decade, and has acquired a wealth of knowledge about currently pending City projects.

b. Jason is terminating his employment with the City effective September 15, 2006.

c. In order to assist the City in managing ongoing City projects the City desires to have Paulsen available for consultation regarding matters pending at the time his employment with the City terminates.

d. Jason wants to help the City in this regard and his new employer has expressed a willingness to allow him to do so.

e. The amount of time this will take is unknown, but Jason's help, when needed, will be invaluable.

3. Availability for Telephonic Consultation.

Jason will remain available for telephonic consultation, on an as needed basis, after he ceases to be a City employee, through December 31, 2006. Jason will provide the City with his daytime phone number, and his cell phone number, and, if not immediately available, shall return calls no later than the next business day.


4. Compensation.

a. In order to minimize bookkeeping for the City, and given the invaluable nature of Jason's services, as full compensation for all services to be rendered, the City shall pay for Jason's COBRA health insurance coverage from the date the City's coverage ends through December 31, 2006.

b. Jason will either forward the invoice for health insurance coverage to the City for direct payment to the insurance carrier by the City, or he may pay the invoice and forward a request for reimbursement to the City. The City agrees to pay the invoice, or reimburse

Jason, as the case may be, within 2 business days after receipt of the invoice or request for reimbursement.


