A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON EXPRESSING THE CITY'S APPRECIATION FOR THE YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE BY JASON PAULSEN, AND DECLARING, BY MAYOR PROCLAMATION, SEPTEMBER 7, 2006 AS JASON PAULSEN APPRECIATION DAY WITHIN THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND


