\$2,001 TO \$25,000	\$140 for the first \$2,000 plus \$17 for each additional \$1,000, or fraction thereof, to and including \$25,000.
\$25,001 TO \$50,000	\$531 for the first \$25,000 plus \$14 for each additional \$1,000, or fraction thereof, to and including \$50,000.
\$50,001 TO \$100,000	\$881 for the first \$50,000 plus \$13 for each additional \$1,000, or fraction thereof, to and including \$100,000.
\$100,001 TO \$500,000	\$1,531 for the first \$100,000 plus \$13 for each additional \$1,000, or fraction thereof, to and including \$500,000.
\$500,001 TO \$1,000,000	\$6,731 for the first \$500,000 plus \$9 for each additional \$1,000, or fraction thereof, to and including \$1,000,000.
\$1,000,001 AND UP	\$11,231 for the first \$1,000,000 plus \$9 for each additional \$1,000, or fraction thereof.
