Project Location: This proposal occurs along the Roberts Drive right of way. The extents of the project start approximately 100 feet west of Rock Creek Bridge (in front of parcel 1521069002) and extend east 1,800 linear feet along Roberts Drive, ending at Cemetery Road (in front of parcel 1521069093).

Project Description: The City of Black Diamond Public Works proposes to reconstruct Roberts Drive from the Rock Creek Bridge to the Black Diamond City Hall, covering approximately 1,800 linear feet. The scope of work includes structural improvements to the bridge, extending utilities across the bridge, and attaching a pedestrian walkway to the south side of the bridge. The roadway within the project area will receive a complete overlay of asphalt, including the installation of sidewalk, curb, gutters, and pedestrian lighting along the south side of the roadway. In association with the roadway improvements, some existing utilities will be relocated within the right-of-way and a new stormwater pipe will be installed to capture additional stormwater runoff resulting from the increase in impervious surfaces.
