Product(s) planned for use: *Alligare Glyphosate 5.4*

Active ingredient(s): *Glyphosate*

Plants/Algae targeted: *Water Lillies*

Location of treatment(s): Near shore water in front of 23210 SE 312th.

The applicator will post signs in the treated and potentially affected areas no more than 48 hours prior to treatment. The signs will describe any water use restrictions or advisories.

If you are withdrawing water for potable or domestic water use, livestock watering, or irrigation, and have no alternate water source, please contact Brent Miller at (206) 321-3288 to arrange an alternate water supply.

Dear Mr. Sawyer:

The Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) received your application for coverage under the Aquatic Plant and Algae Management NPDES and State Waste Discharge General Permit (permit). Ecology is issuing you coverage under the permit as of June 2, 2017. Retain this letter with your permit documents. It is part of the official record of permit coverage.

Treatment Timing Window

Ecology is conditioning this permit coverage for some active ingredients to mitigate impacts to salmonids and Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife priority habitats and species using Treatment Timing Windows. Treatment Timing Windows set periods of time during which treatment with specific herbicides is allowed. For this coverage the Treatment Timing Windows are:

Waterbody Treatment Timing Window:	July 15-December 31 (Dates are inclusive)

Permit Fees

State law (RCW 90.48.465) requires that all Permittees pay an annual permit fee based upon the state fiscal year. The state fiscal year begins each year on July 1, and ends on June 30 the following year. Ecology mails permit fee bills to all Permittees annually. Permittees that have permit coverage on July 1 will receive a permit fee bill. 
