# Definitions:

CFS	Call For Service.
Traffic Stop	Officer initiated traffic stop - radio initiated.
MD Traffic Stop	Officer initiated traffic stop - mobile data initiated.
Downloaded CFS	CFS meeting criteria to be handled directly by station personnel.
Duplicates	Calls for service that duplicate another CFS.
Cancelled	CAD Incident cancelled prior to dispatch.
Dispatchable Calls for Service	Requests from public and officer initiated incidents.
BOLO/INFO	For tracking dispatch related functions, such as broadcasts and information not associated with an individual department,
Non Mobile Transports	VCC initiated inmate transport; Officer request.
Mobile Transports	Officer initiated inmate transport via mobile data.

# **CFS Calculations:**

Traffic Stop &	Each counted as one half of a CFS for owner apportionment calculation and invoiced
Downloaded CFS	as one half a CFS for contract agency billing.
Duplicates, Cancelled & MD Traffic Stops	Not included in owner apportionment or contract agency billing.
Dispatchable Calls for Service	Each counted as one CFS for owner apportionment calculation and invoiced as one CFS for contract agency billing.
BOLO/INFO	Not included in owner apportionment or contract agency billing.
Non Mobile Transports	Counted as one full CFS for contract agency billing.
Mobile Transports	Not included in contract agency billing.
