**Definitions:**

<b>CFS</b>	Call For Service.
<b>Traffic Stop</b>	Officer initiated traffic stop - radio initiated.
<b>MD Traffic Stop</b>	Officer initiated traffic stop - mobile data initiated.
<b>Downloaded CFS</b>	CFS meeting criteria to be handled directly by station personnel.
<b>Duplicates</b>	Calls for service that duplicate another CFS.
<b>Cancelled</b>	CAD Incident cancelled prior to dispatch.
<b>Dispatchable Calls for Service</b>	Requests from public and officer initiated incidents.
<b>BOLO/INFO</b>	For tracking dispatch related functions, such as broadcasts and information not associated with an individual department.
<b>Non Mobile Transports</b>	VCC initiated inmate transport; Officer request.
<b>Mobile Transports</b>	Officer initiated inmate transport via mobile data.

**CFS Calculations:**

<b>Traffic Stop &amp; Downloaded CFS</b>	Each counted as one half of a CFS for owner apportionment calculation and invoiced as one half a CFS for contract agency billing.
<b>Duplicates, Cancelled &amp; MD Traffic Stops</b>	Not included in owner apportionment or contract agency billing.
<b>Dispatchable Calls for Service</b>	Each counted as one CFS for owner apportionment calculation and invoiced as one CFS for contract agency billing.
<b>BOLO/INFO</b>	Not included in owner apportionment or contract agency billing.
<b>Non Mobile Transports</b>	Counted as one full CFS for contract agency billing.
<b>Mobile Transports</b>	Not included in contract agency billing.
