



CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION VACANCY

The City of Black Diamond is seeking applicants for the Civil Service Commission to fill an expired six-year term. The term for this position will commence when filled, and will expire December 31, 2020. Members are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council.

The Civil Service Commission consists of three (3) members. The Commission ensures the fair employment hiring process and equitable disciplinary action for commissioned police officers. The Commission typically meets once per month on a Thursday morning, but may meet more frequently if needed.

Any resident of Black Diamond who is a US Citizen, has lived in the City limits for three years and is a registered voter is encouraged to submit an application to serve the community on this important Commission. To be considered for this position applications need to be received by 4:00 p.m. on April 30, 2015. Interviews for this position will take place sometime the week of May 4-7, 2015.
