## Determination of Non-significance (DNS) File Number PLN15-0025

**Name of proposal:** North Bank Artesian Spring Pump Test

**Description of proposal:** The City will be performing a pumping test from the flooded Gem Seam Air Shaft. A portable pump or pumps will be delivered on the existing gravel road and an intake line or lines will be laid on the ground surface from the pump location to the shaft, a distance of approximately 200 feet. From the pump, water will be carried approximately 200 feet on the ground surface through hose/pipe along the existing roadway and down the bank of the Green River for discharge through a diffuser into the Green River.

**Location of proposal:** Parcel 1921079030

**Lead agency:** City of Black Diamond
