NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF SEPA MITIGATED DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (MDNS)

NOTICE is hereby given that the **MITIGATED DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (MDNS)** made by the City of Black Diamond for the **Robert's Drive Reconstruction** project is hereby withdrawn.

WITHDRAWAL OF MDNS:

The City of Black Diamond issued a MDNS for this project action on September 27, 2016 with a comment period ending on October 11, 2016. The reason for this withdrawal is to consider procedural revisions. A new threshold determination with a public comment period will be issued at a future date.

APPLICATION FILE NUMBER: PLN16-0040

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Reconstruct Roberts Drive from Rock Creek Bridge to the Black Diamond City Hall. The scope of work includes structural improvements to the bridge, widening the shoulders, adding parking, curb, gutter and pervious concrete sidewalks on the south side of Roberts Drive. The roadway within the project area will receive a complete overlay of asphalt. A new stormwater pipe will be installed to capture additional stormwater runoff resulting from the increase in impervious surfaces. The project would add approximately 2,000 square feet of impervious surface and disturbs about 7,000 sq. ft. of land.

LOCATION OF PROPOSAL: This proposal occurs along the Roberts Drive right of way. The extents of the project start approximately 100 feet west of Rock Creek Bridge (in front of parcel 1521069002) and extend east 1,800 linear feet along Roberts Drive, ending at Cemetery Road (in front of parcel 1521069093).
