

King County 2010 Pet License Fees



FEES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010

In addition to the fee changes, pet owners found without a pet license will be issued a penalty as part of a new "No Tolerance" program. This NO Tolerance program will be launched with an amnesty period in which penalties for not licensing will be waived for citizens who purchase or renew licenses. This amnesty period will be July 1, 2010 through September 30, 2010. During this period, late fees or penalties will be waived and you will only be charged the license fee.



LICENSE TYPE	FEES EFFECTIVE 7/1/10
Juvenile	\$15 (price increase)
Altered	\$30 (no change)
Unaltered	\$60 (price reduction)
Senior Citizens	Senior Citizen licenses purchased on or before June 30, 2010 will continue to be renewed automatically each year at a \$0 cost. Senior Citizen licenses purchased on or after July 1, 2010 will cost \$15 (50% of the altered license) and the license will need to be renewed annually.
Disabled	\$15 annual fee with application. Direct applicants to Pet Licensing Office at (206) 296-2712.
Service Animals	Free with owners' signed statement that they have a disability and that their animal is used to assist them due to their disability.
